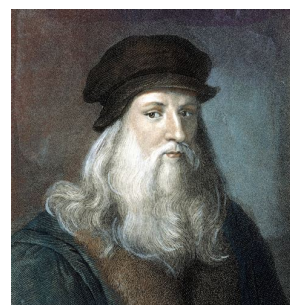


MIRROR WRITING

Mirror Writing

This means that he writes in a way that is not directly readable, but will be if you look at it through a mirror. For example, this is what the scholarship logo would look like in mirror writing:
